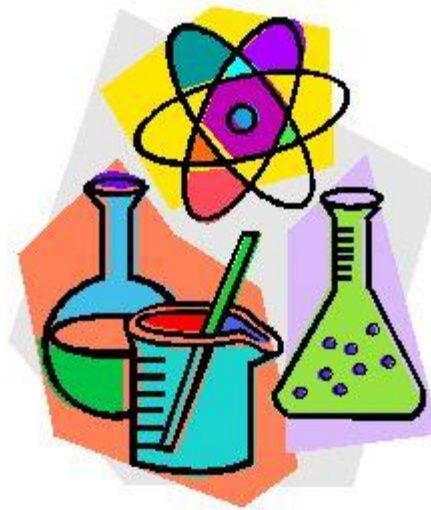
# INTRODUCTION

# ORGANIZERS

- A group of students that volunteer
  - Put a list for the students where they can volunteer in the office
  - Min. 4 students
- Volunteering groups eg. football club could organize the football competition
- 2 teachers (not as teachers but coaches)
- School councils can join the different schools in their country

# How to motivate them?

- Organizers can get a certificate from their school so that they can add it on their CV's
- In their 11<sup>th</sup> or 12<sup>th</sup> school year they're obligated to be organizers at least once in a school year in one competition

# REWARDS

## VIVOS

- UK uses rewarding techniques such as VIVOS
- To engage students too start learning
- Way to earn points during lessons eg. 100% attendance or volunteer into help for charity
- 1 VIVO = 1p/1 cent
- VIVOS can add up to buy gifts eg. Hair bands, gift cards,...
- Goal is to keep students engaged in lessons and make them want to do well.
- Good for younger students

- Ice skating
- Bowling
- Fun Fair
- Zoo
- Aquarium

Day Trips could be sponsored and in return the students in the competition could use t-shirts with their logo.

- Students get one week without homework

Separate them by age so for example

- 11-14
- 14-16
- 16-19
