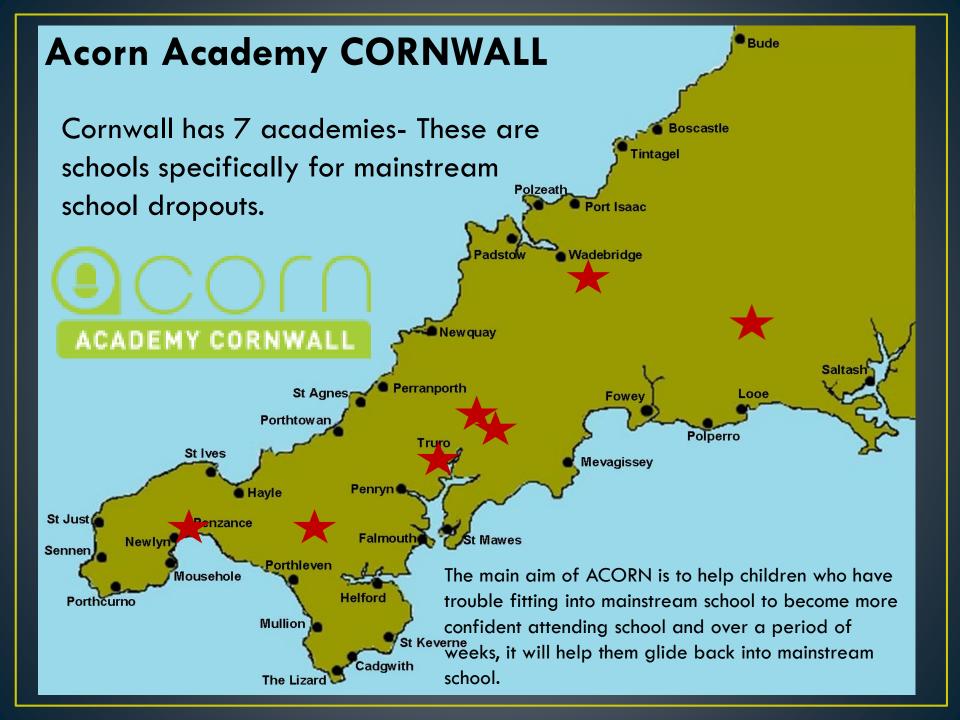

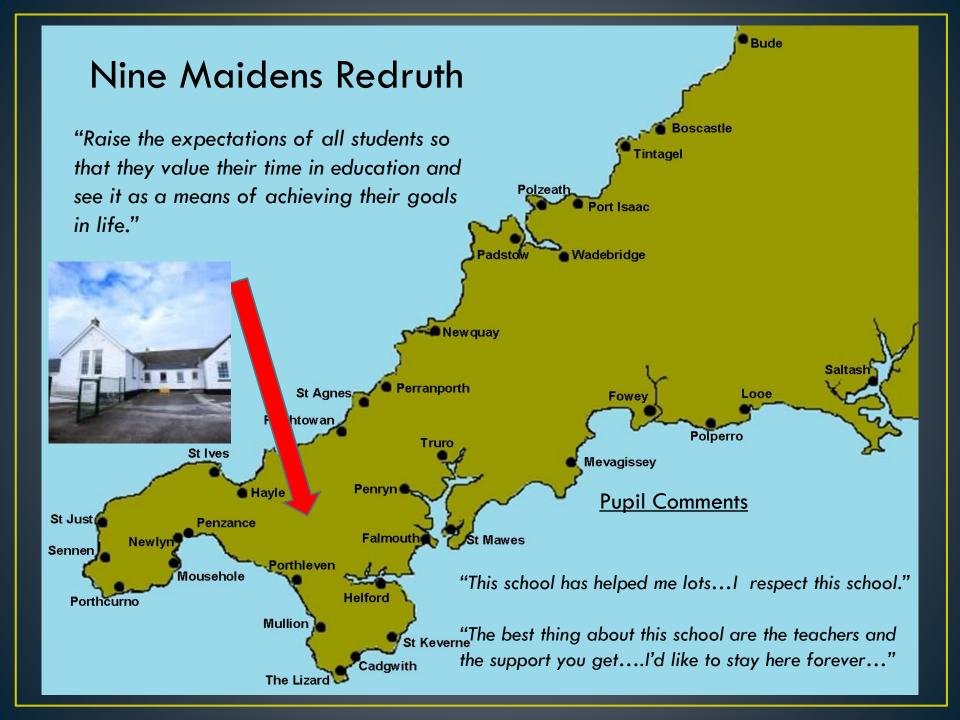


Gary Owens - Headteacher
