After the students had spent their week in Luxemburg, they prepared individual written reports about the year's project, reflecting on the work they have done, the benefits they experienced and what they have learned. These individual reports were combined into a complete report (see attachment 1).

They also prepared a short presentation for the second classes of our school to report on what they have done, show the students the value of the project work and to encourage these students to participate in an Erasmus+ project in the future.

The second class students were able to ask questions about the experiences of the older students.
